Lake Afton Flying Field

GPS Coordinates: 37° 36' 38" N - 97° 37' 58" W

Lake Afton Park is located west of Wichita and south of Goddard at 25313 W. 39th St. South and is governed and controlled by Sedgwick County Parks Dept. The flying field is located on the west side of the lake and has been open to the public for sport and hobby model flying since 1985. In 1992 the Wichita Radio Control Club erected a field shelter and donated it to the park.

Note: The County requires that all flyers provide proof of insurance on demand. AMA membership fulfills this requirement. Field rules are posted on the west side of the flying field shelter.
